

# 2010 MCC Junior Golf

## “Rules and Procedures”

1. The 2010 sign-up form must be returned to the Golf Shop by **Sunday, May 16**.
2. Caddie walkers will be assigned based on returned sign-up forms. Please help us plan for enough caddies by filling out the enclosed sign-up form.
3. Junior golfers and parents are responsible for knowing the “Rules and Regulations for Juniors” as printed in the “Milwaukee Country Club Directory”.
4. The Junior Golf Lesson times are as follows:
  - 18 Holes 7:30 - 8:00 a.m.
  - 9 Holes 8:00 - 8:45 a.m.
  - 6 Holes 8:45 - 9:45 a.m.
  - 3 Holes 8:45 - 9:45 a.m.
5. Pee Wee Golf Lessons - 9:45 – 10:15 a.m. Parents must supervise children during “Pee Wee” lessons.
6. Thursday morning shall be Junior Play Day on the course.

The tee time schedule will be as follows:

18 holes	7:30 - 8:10 a.m. (start on #1 / boys white tees girls red tees)
9 holes	8:20 - 9:20 a.m. (start on #1 / boys and girls red tees)
6 holes	9:30 - 10:50 a.m. (Start on #1 / boys and girls yellow tees in fairway)
3 holes	9:30 - 10:50 a.m. (Start on #14 / boys and girls green tees in fairway)

### 7. **Schedule and View Junior Golf Tee Times Online!!!**

This season we will be using the Club’s online tee time reservation system to schedule and view starting times for Junior Golf play days.

#### **Here’s How:**

- Go to [www.foretees.com/milwaukee](http://www.foretees.com/milwaukee)
- **Type your child’s Login** – If your member number is 3 digits, your oldest child will add a “30” in front of your member number. Your second oldest child will add a “40” in front of your member number etc... Families with a 4 digit member number add “3” or “4” etc... to your member number.
- **Type your child’s password** – Your password is your **last name**. If your last name is less than 4 characters, keep adding a “1” to the end of your last name until you get to four characters. If your last name is longer than ten characters, truncate your last name at the tenth character.
- **Now you’re in the tee time book!**
- **Important** – Go to the “Settings” tab and change your child’s password. This will ensure that no one else has access to their tee times.
- **Enter the email address** you wish to use to receive automatic email confirmations of your child’s tee times.

### To schedule a tee time:

- **Remember, Thursday morning is for Juniors only. If you login as an adult you will not be able to schedule a tee time for your child. In order to schedule a tee time for your child, you must login using your child's login I.D.**
- Go to the "Tee times" tab and select "**Make, Change, or View Tee Times.**"
- Left click the Thursday morning your child wants to play. You will only be able to schedule tee times **7 days** in advance. The date you wish to schedule must appear as a green box, otherwise it is for viewing only.
- 18 Hole times appear in "Yellow" 7:30 – 8:10 a.m.
- 9 Hole times appear in "Red" 8:20 – 9:20 a.m.
- 6 Hole times appear in "Blue" 9:30 – 10:50 a.m.
- 3 Hole times appear in "Green" 9:30 – 10:50 a.m.
- After clicking on the time you want to play, the system brings you to the "ForeTees Member Reservation" page where you can make, edit, or delete a tee time. Once you are to the "ForeTees Member Reservations" page, **never use your browser's "Back" button to get back to the tee sheet!!** Use the "**Go Back**" button located just to the left of the "Add or Remove Players" box.
- **Add or Remove Players Box:** Notice that your child's name automatically appears in the first available spot for this tee time. Just to the right of your child's name is the "**Trans**" drop-down menu. The default mode is "W" or walk for all Junior golfers. For all 9, 6, and 3 hole Juniors, select the "**9 Holes**" box.
- **Partner List:** The "Partner List" can be created to include up to 25 other Junior golfers with whom your child plays with most regularly. Once this list is set up, it will allow you to expedite the tee time making process.
- **Member List:** Every individual at the Club who has playing privileges on the course is located in this panel alphabetically by last name. Once you have found the person your child wants to play with, simply left click on their name and that person will appear in the "Add or Remove Players" box. If you click on the wrong name, click on the "Erase" link that corresponds with the incorrect name in the "Add or Remove Player" box. **Players' names should not be typed into the "Add or Remove Players" box!!! These selections should be made by using the point-and click method with you computer's mouse.**

8. All groups will be limited to 4 players. It is the responsibility of the parent rangers to make sure that each group plays at an acceptable pace and all rules are followed.
9. Each and every time a Junior golfer plays a round of golf, his/her score should be turned in at the Golf Shop. Those Juniors who know how to use the handicap computer may enter their scores themselves, but the cards should also be turned in.
10. The Head Golf Professional in conjunction with the Junior Golf Committee will make the decision as to when a Junior golfer is ready to move up to the next level, (i.e. from 3 holes to 6 holes). Should the Junior decide not to move, he/she will forfeit all prizes at the lower level.

11. Juniors may use the practice range on Weekdays - from 8:00-12:00 p.m., 2:00-4:00 p.m. & after 6:00 p.m. and on Weekends/Holidays - After 1:00 p.m.
12. Juniors are able to play on Saturdays after 1:30 p.m. and Sundays after 2:00 p.m.
13. Juniors must adhere to the Milwaukee Country Club Dress Code outlined on page 25. of the Club Directory. Normal golfing attire is short or long sleeved collared shirts, trousers or knee-length shorts. Shirts must be tucked in and caps must be worn in the bill forward fashion. Tennis shorts, swim suits, cut-offs, track shorts, cargo shorts and cargo pants will not be allowed on the course or in the practice areas. An exception to this rule will be made for Juniors 12 and under who may play in tennis attire. Shirts and shoes shall be worn at all times.
